AWARDS OF DISTINCTION

The Catholic Community Foundation of Waterloo Region and the St. Jerome's High School Memorial Fund have established the '*Awards of Distinction*' program honouring Catholic secondary school graduates who demonstrated exemplary performance in one or more of the award categories through academic achievement and participation in extra-curricular school activities.

Six monetary awards (\$100.00 each) supporting post-secondary studies will be presented to six graduates at each secondary school during the annual graduation ceremony. The award categories include:

1. The Arts (Performing Arts, Visual, Music)
2. Athleticism
3. Math, Science, or Technology
4. School and Community Volunteerism
5. Faith and Social Justice
6. Catholic Youth Leadership

Eligible graduating students would have maintained a minimum grade average of 75 percent their top six (6) grade 12 courses and participated in the extra-curricular life of the school related to the award category for which they are applying.

The '*Awards of Distinction*' demonstrate the foundation's commitment to supporting Catholic Youth with their educational pursuits and preparation for Christian service within their families and communities.

The deadline for submission of the self-nominating application form to your guidance teacher is **Monday, May 16, 2022**. Students may submit an application for more than one award category but no student will receive more than one award.
