

## THE PROGRAM

The Graduation Coach Program provides intensive, culturally relevant and responsive support to Black, African, and Caribbean students. This coach helps the students with personal well-being, school engagement, academic goal setting and achievement, and post-secondary transitions. Researchers have concluded that our young Black people are less likely than their counterparts in the rest of the population to have a post secondary certificate, diploma, or degree. This leads to a lifetime of systemic inequities. The Graduation Coach Program challenges the outcomes.
